

The Norma Livingston Ovarian Cancer Foundation and the UAB Comprehensive Cancer Center announce the creation of the nation's first Ovarian Cancer car tag. The tag received legislative approval and the commitment phase has begun. When 1,000 individuals across Alabama commit to purchase the tag, it will go into production.

The car tag is tax deductible and costs \$50.00 more than a standard Alabama car tag. \$41.25 will go directly to ovarian cancer research at UAB.

“Funding research for ovarian cancer is limited, so we must look to innovative funding from individuals and organizations that share our passion in the fight against the disease,” says Dr. Ed Partridge, Director of The UAB Comprehensive Cancer Center.
